

Pursuant to Article 55 Paragraph 1 of the Law on Organization and Operation of the State Administration ("Official Gazette" No 58/00, 44/02, 82/08, 167/10 and 51/11) and the Handbook on the Procedures for IPA coordinator of the third component of regional development – Section Environment, version 3.0 (approved in June 2010), the Minister of Environment and Physical Planning adopts a:

DECISION

on establishing a Steering Committee to monitor the project "Development of Regional Waste Management Plans and Strategic Environmental Assessments for East and North-East Regions"

(EuropeAid/130400/D/SER/MK)

Article 1

A Steering Committee to monitor the project "Development of Regional Waste Management Plans and Strategic Environmental Assessments for East and North-East Regions" (hereinafter Project) is established by this Decision. The composition of the Steering Committee is as follows:

Article 3

The Steering Committee is authorized to adopt Rules of Procedure at its first meeting, which will further regulate the responsibilities and the work of the Steering Committee.

Article 4

If deemed necessary, the Steering Committee may also invite other prominent experts from the Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning as well as external experts to attend the meetings of the group.

Article 5

A copy of this Decision shall be submitted to the chairman, members, deputy members and observers of the Steering Committee monitors and to the Archive of the Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning.

Article 6

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption.
