The Project Team visited each of the Beneficiaries during the Inception Period which ended on 20<sup>th</sup> February to introduce the Project Team and to receive initial views and opinions.

The Project Team prepared a stakeholder questionnaire in March which was completed by all Beneficiaries and provided the basis for the Stakeholder Involvement Plan which was delivered in draft form on 02.06.2015.

The SIP was presented and discussed at a workshop held on 12<sup>th</sup> June to which all Beneficiaries and Municipalities were invited. The nine pilot Municipalities were well represented together with the Municipalities of Valandovo, Rankovce, Kratovo, and Kriva Palanka who met with the Project Team for the first time. There was active discussion of the difficulties facing Municipalities in implementation of environmental legislation and how these difficulties might be overcome. The ideas developed will be included at least in part in the Communication and Coordination Plan currently under preparation.

The draft Communication and Coordination Plan will be circulated to all Beneficiaries in July. The Plan presents ideas for improving communication and coordination not only between and within Beneficiaries but also with other stakeholders identified in the SIP. Most recent activities include the introduction of the Project legal team to the Beneficiaries and the circulation of an Institutional Questionnaire.

The Project legal team is carrying out a review of the existing environmental legislation and will prepare a legal analysis report. In parallel a soon to be recruited Institutional and Financial Experts will use the information provided from the Questionnaire to prepare an institutional analysis report. Both reports will be used as inputs to the development of a proposed Programme of Reform currently planned to be delivered for discussion in September.

The Project Team will prepare a sixth month progress Report in August for discussion at the second Project Steering Committee Meeting planned for early September.

The Project Team would like to thank all the Beneficiaries for their willingness to give of their time to work within the Project and look forward to further meetings as the Project progresses.

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
